A room at Baba Tonka House was temporarily transformed into a small but cosy therapy space, improvising with physio balls, gym mat, parachute, bean bags, sensory objects, games etc.

Children!

We enjoyed lively individual sessions with twelve wonderful children at home, school, day centre and Baba Tonka House, meeting many of them and their parents for the first time. We began to get to know them and assess their postural, mobility, seating, communication and sensory processing needs. Many wheelchairs and buggies were checked and adjusted, particularly in the small group homes. Laura assessed children that have feeding and swallowing difficulties

Equipment!

More equipment was issued from Baba Tonka House to meet assessed needs. With the help of Friendship volunteers, many more items have been collected and delivered to Social Care Homes, Baby Homes and families elsewhere in Bulgaria, enhancing mobility, independence and quality of life

We shared news and exchanged ideas with many friends, with and without disabilities; Appreciated fine weather and blue skies throughout the week; Enjoyed lots of lovely Bulgarian food;
